Introduction

A thorough understanding of grammar is essential to mastering any language. Likewise, getting to grips with Spanish grammar is essential for success in your AS and A-level exams. Grammar is a key part of AO3, the ability to manipulate language accurately, in spoken and written forms, using a range of lexis and structures. Depending on the exam board you are studying, AO3 could account for 30% of your mark at AS and A-level, so it is worth investing some time to make sure you understand the grammar rules and know how to put them into practice.

This workbook has been designed to help build your confidence in Spanish grammar to help prepare you for your AS and A-level exams. It will help to embed your understanding of grammar throughout your course, as well as help will exam revision. You might find it useful to complete one or two exercises for each grammar point throughout your course, and then return to complete the remaining exercises for each grammar point before your exams.

All the grammar points you need to know for your AS and A-level exams are included across Workbook 1 (ISBN 9781510416741) and Workbook 2. If at AS you only need a receptive knowledge of a grammar point, this will be indicated.

The grammar references used (A1, A2 etc.) match those used in the following textbooks, which you may be using:

- *Edexcel A level Spanish (includes AS)* (ISBN 9781471858314)
